<u>Awareness</u> of Mortality



Eleanor Harrison Bregman, who serves as a Protestant chaplain at Jewish Home Lifecare, a nursing facility in New York City, wrote these words on the ritual of Ash Wednesday:

As the priest puts the ashes on my forehead, [saying] "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," I remember putting the ashes of my mother's remains into the earth a little over two years ago. This is real. Death will happen, someday....As I approached the priest this morning and those memories surfaced. I wept, and I thought, "Oh my God, it really is all going to end. It ended for my mother, it will end for me, someday, too.... Yet immediately upon the heels of that fear - almost terror - of dying, something else even more powerful welled up. I felt deep, deep thanksgiving for life. It is when vou walk right up to vour own mortality, or the mortality of those you love, that you know what and for whom you live and love. If you are lucky, you feel the grace of God so deeply that you know that even when it seems like it is all over. it isn't, because we are all resting in the palm of God's hand, now and forever.

During this Lenten Season we journey with the Lord Jesus as he approaches death and the Resurrection. May God bless our <u>Journey from</u> **Ashes to Easter**.






