(the name means "twin")

Thomas is the disciple from Missouri, the "Show Me" state. The Thomas episode wrestles with a problem affecting many. How can one believe in the Risen Lord without having seen him?

Thomas insists on seeing and touching. He demands the miraculous and extraordinary. Thomas is on the wrong track.

Once you begin to require outward signs to confirm your faith, you'll never be satisfied. This is shrinking from the true adventure of faith. Belief is the acceptance of a word. True recognition is in hearing and believing the words of Jesus.

The gospel seems to go out of its way to point out to us that <u>Thomas was a twin</u>. Who is Thomas' twin? The answer: we are Thomas' twin. For all of us are a mixture of belief and doubt. We hanker for the certainty of a sign, but faith doesn't work that way.

"Blessed are they who have not seen, yet believe." Faith is really a matter of <u>trust</u> Jesus is as good as His Word.
