

September 26 – Paul VI (d. 1978) Presided over most of Vatican II. Last Pope to

receive papal coronation. Wrote about evangelization and natural reproductive methods. September 27– Vincent de Paul (d. 1660) Champion of the poor. Advisor to royalty. Founded the Daughters of Charity. Numerous charitable societies are named after him.
