

No matter your personal history, age, income, background, gender, race, ethnicity or spirituality, or marital situation, No matter your own self-image of holiness or virtue,


You belong to Jesus Christ and you belong to us!

### The Presence of Christ

The continuing presence of the Risen Christ is the central reality of our life of faith. This is the presence which Christ promised would remain with His Church until the end of time (Matthew 28:20). In the course of the life of the Church, this presence shows itself in various ways, but especially in the Mass. There, Christ is present already from the beginning in the congregation gathered in His name. He is present in the reading and preaching of the Word of God and in the celebration of the memorial of Christ's death and resurrection. But He is present in an altogether special way when, by the action of the Holy Spirit, bread and wine are changed into His Body and Blood. As a result, in Holy Communion, according to the words of the Gospel, we eat the flesh of Christ and drink His blood (John 6:53).

In thinking about this mystery, it helps us if we keep in mind that we are not just talking about communion with a fellow human being but with the Son of God Himself. By choosing to bring this about through the forms of food and drink, Jesus is indicating that just as bread and wine nourish the natural life of our bodies, so does the divine sacrament nourish our inner being, our mind and heart, to enable us to "grow in love" and so to become more like Christ.

#### **Collecting Blessed Palms**


Bring in your Blessed Palms and place palms in designated baskets located at the entrances of the church.

# Why the 200 Club?

The purpose of the 200 Club is to supplement the weekly collection in support of parish operations, programs and services. This additional revenue is required to offset variations in the weekly collections and the reduced income from some of the more traditional Parish fundraising activities. Specifically:

Our demographics are changing and the resources to conduct these traditional fundraising activities are diminishing.

Free time for many of our parishioners is an increasingly rare commodity making it difficult to engage in labor-intensive parish maintenance and fund-raising activities.

Despite aggressive expense controls, costs continue to rise for virtually all parish programs, pastoral, educational and diocesan as well as facilities maintenance, repair and utilities.

# 200 Club Rules

The Club is run by an administrative committee consisting of 4 Co-Chairs with the assistance of the St. Thomas More Finance committee.

The target is to have 200 members. Membership options are \$50 for a 3-month membership, \$100 for a 6-month membership and \$200 for a full year's membership.

Only parishioners can promote and/or solicit memberships.

Membership is open to all parishioners, relatives and friends 18 years of age and older. Membership numbers will be assigned on a first come/first served basis.

Numbers will be drawn monthly for 3 prizes: \$100, \$50 and \$25. Checks for prizes will be mailed to the lucky winners. Anniversary drawing prizes will be \$500, \$300 and \$100.

Only the numbers of members who are up to date in their monthly payments will be entered in the monthly drawing.

Members can win more than once.

After payment of prize money and related expenses, all revenues will become part of the St. Thomas More general fund. For the calendar year 2025, 200 Club revenues will be earmarked for support of the much-needed repairs and upgrades to the rectory.
