

# First Sunday of Lent

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new & right spirit within me.-

Psalm 51:10



"To err is human, to forgive divine."

If we have no desire to forgive someone, then the place to begin is with prayer for a desire - or even more basic, for a desire to have a desire. Here is one example of how to speak to God about it. Reword this prayer to fit the circumstances of your particular situation and say the name of the person who hurt you:

Lord, even though I hate  $N_{\bullet}$ , I realize that deliberately wanting to hold on to such hate is not healthy, nor does it reflect the attitude and behavior that one of your disciples should have.

I admit my own helplessness in this matter. I trust in you and your power to help me to do that which I cannot do for myself. You know my heart is hardened against N. at present. You know that I have no desire to forgive. But I believe you can help me. If you could open the eyes of the blind and enable the crippled to walk, then you can surely soften and heal this heart of mine that is full of hate at present.

Have a blessed and forgiving Lent.
