Thomas wisely advises us that life should not be rushed. We must take time for "turning aside."

We are looking for volunteers to bring side dishes/ desserts. We also need help with <u>cooking</u>, <u>set-up</u> and clean-up.





New Keyboard & Sound System for Our Music Ministry!

Our current keyboard has been in a continuing decline in terms of the functioning of keys and pedals and we very much appreciate the importance of music in our worship services. The Parish Finance Council is planning to replace the current keyboard with a new one. The new one we have selected is the newest version of this same make and model as the current keyboard and has been recommended by the Music Ministry. The total cost of the new keyboard is **approximately \$2,500** and a **sound system \$1,300.00**. Already, a few Parishioners have expressed an interest in donating toward this acquisition to help defray the

cost. We believe others may want to do the same. We are planning to acquire the new keyboard through our Sponsorship Program. 
