TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Thus says the Lord: 'I know their works and their thoughts, and I come to gather nations of every language; they shall come to see my glory. I will set a sign among them, from them I shall send fugitives to the nations...that have never heard of my name or seen my glory, and they shall proclaim my glory among the nations."... "For behold some of the last will be first, and some of the first will be last."
