Child of Bethlehem



Joseph does not figure prominently in the scriptures or in the Liturgy. Yet popular devotion has appreciated his role in the events surrounding the birth of the Christ child. He is asked to recognize the child as his own and so guarantee its legal status. His acceptance of his role and Mary's similar acceptance of hers is a model for Christian discipleship.

The fourth Sunday of Advent falls during the second part of Advent when there is an increase in pace, intensity and expectation. The ancient "O Antiphons" are used daily from December 17 until Christmas Eve and contribute to the heightened sense of waiting.

The "O Antiphons" were already in use by the Eighth Century and together form the tapestry of titles for Jesus in the mystery of his Incarnation: **Wisdom, Lord, Root of Jesse, Key of David, Rising Sun, King of Nations and Emmanuel.**

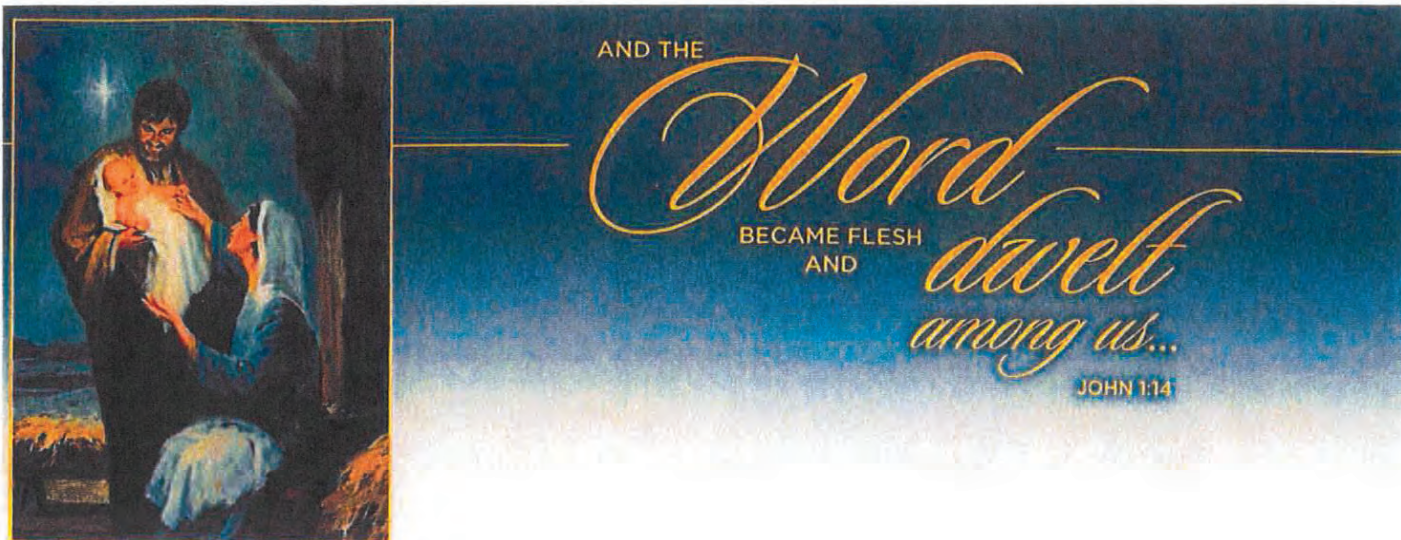
