Lent is the springtime of the Church's year. The word itself probably comes from the Old English "lencten," which refers to the lengthening of the day-time hours. Spring is a good image for what this season means: new life, hope, joy in the gifts of God that surround us.

Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are traditional Lenten activities. When they are freely undertaken, they are ways in which a person actively turns toward God and signals one's willingness to journey with the Lord on the road to Jerusalem.

Our reception of ashes this Wednesday means we recognize ourselves as sinners. In the Bible, to cover one's head with ashes and to fast are penitential signs; they express the sinner's repentance imploring God's mercy. May faith in the Lord help us pass with Him from death to life.

Why the 200 Club?

The purpose of the 200 Club is to supplement the weekly collection in support of parish operations, programs and services. This additional revenue is required to offset variations in the weekly collections and the reduced income from some of the more traditional Parish fundraising activities.

Specifically:

Our demographics are changing and the resources to conduct these traditional fundraising activities are diminishing.

Free time for many of our parishioners is an increasingly rare commodity making it difficult to engage in labor-intensive parish maintenance and fund-raising activities.

Despite aggressive expense controls, costs continue to rise for virtually all parish programs, pastoral, educational and diocesan, as well as facilities maintenance, repair and utilities.

200 Club Rules

The Club is run by an administrative committee consisting of 4 Co-Chairs with the assistance of the St. Thomas More Finance committee.

The target is to have 200 members. Membership options are \$50 for a 3-month membership, \$100 for a 6-month membership and \$200 for a full year's membership.

Only parishioners can promote and/or solicit memberships.

Membership is open to all parishioners, relatives and friends 18 years of age and older. Membership numbers will be assigned on a first come/first served basis.

Numbers will be drawn monthly for 3 prizes: \$100, \$50 and \$25. Checks for prizes will be mailed to the lucky winners. Anniversary drawing prizes will be \$500, \$300 and \$100.

Only the numbers of members who are up to date in their monthly payments will be entered in the monthly drawing.

Members can win more than once.

After payment of prize money and related expenses, all revenues will become part of the St. Thomas More general fund. For the calendar year 2026, 200 Club revenues will be earmarked for support of the much-needed repairs and upgrades to the rectory and the foyer of the Church.
